




205. a.—Pylône figuré chez Mery-Re'.


207.—Pylône avec portique (Maḥou).












220.—Pylône figuré sur un relief du temple




223 b.—Élévation de l'un des deux pylônes précédents d'après Foucart.




225.—Élévation du pylône du temple d'Amun à Karnak, par le peintre Neb-Re' (Berlin 20377).


224.—Pylône de chapelle chez Neb-Amoun.






218.—Pylône (Panehsy).




219.—Élévation d'un pylône (Panehsy).
