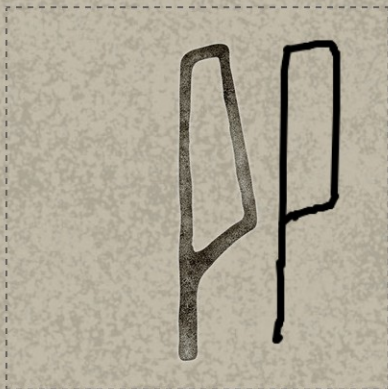

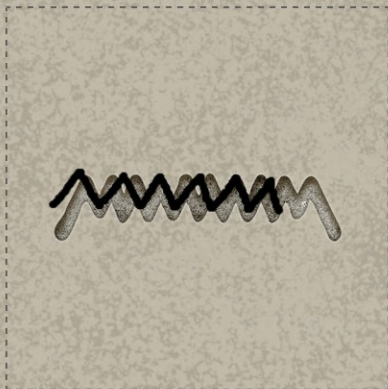

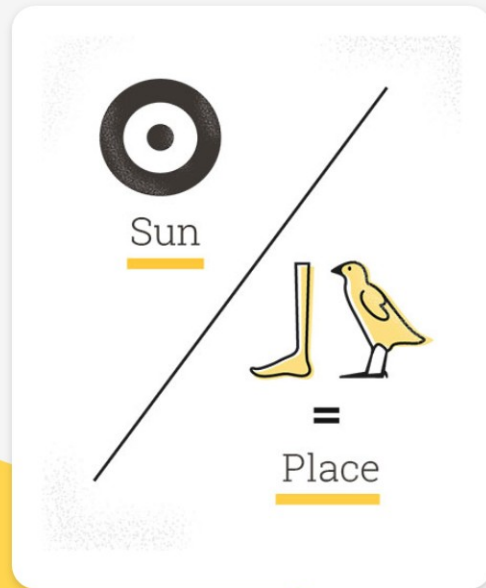

Key facts

Each pharaoh was believed to be the living image of the god Amun. During Tutankhamun's reign, Amun was the most important state deity, but earlier rulers were associated with the gods Horus or Re.

The easiest way to understand hieroglyphs is to imagine that they are the ancient Egyptian equivalent of **emojis**.
